



Yellow Voter Confirmation Cards

Nearly 40,000 Benton County residents received postcards in the mail asking to confirm or cancel their voter registration. Response to these blue or yellow postcards is vital to ensure each resident can vote in upcoming elections.

Did you receive a yellow address confirmation notice?

Residents received a **yellow postcard** if they did not previously respond to a blue postcard two years ago and who have not voted in any election in the last four years. This postcard is a notice of impending cancellation. Voters need to fill out the yellow postcard and send back to the County Clerk's office. This is also postmarked. If the resident does not send back the notice of impending cancellation within thirty days, the voter's registration will be cancelled and the voter will need to re-register to vote.

Why is the County Clerk's office doing this?

The County Clerk's main goal in sending out these postcards is to confirm current information ahead of the 2020 election. It is a process required by state law to be performed every two years and will be conducted by county clerks throughout the state.

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NOTICE OF IMPENDING CANCELLATION OF VOTER REGISTRATION

According to our records you have not responded to our address confirmation notice and you have not voted in any election during the period beginning on the date of the notice and ending on the day after the date of the second general election for federal office after the date of the first notice. This may indicate that you no longer live at the residence address printed on the postcard. If your permanent residence address is still the same as the printed address on this postcard **YOU MUST CONFIRM YOUR RESIDENCE ADDRESS in order to remain on the voter registration list. PLEASE CONFIRM BY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:**

If you do not confirm within thirty (30) days after the date postmarked on this card, YOUR REGISTRATION WILL BE CANCELLED and you will have to re-register to vote.
